



OVERDOSE SIGNS




Slow or NO

sounds.





OPS hours: Monday to Sunday, 10 am to 10 pm

Have a safety plan:

- ✓ Don't use alone, use with someone you trust
- ✓ If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- ✓ When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- ✓ Carry and know how to use naloxone
- ✓ Test a small amount and go slow
- ✓ Take into account a potential decrease in tolerance and isolation due to hot weather
- ✓ **Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses**
