### DRUG CHARACTERISTICS

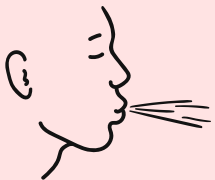
#### Substance(s)

Pressed pills sold as oxycodone. The pills tested positive for flourofentanyl (fentanyl analogue) and bromazolam (benzo).

#### Response(s)

This drug has been linked to an increase in overdoses.

### OVERDOSE SIGNS



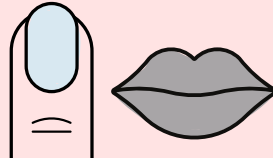
Slow or NO breathing.



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds.



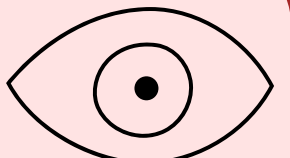
Person isn't moving. Can't be woken up.



Lips & nails may look blue or grey



Skin feels cold or clammy.



Pupils are tiny.

**Address:** 1126 3rd Ave, Prince George, BC Tuesday to Saturday, 8 am to 1 pm; Tuesday to Friday, 5 pm to 9 pm (Sample drop off available during OPS hours)

**Drug checking:** Tuesday to Saturday, 12 pm to 4 pm

#### Have a safety plan:

- ✓ Don't use alone, use with someone you trust
- ✓ If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- ✓ When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- ✓ Carry and know how to use naloxone
- ✓ Test a small amount and go slow
- ✓ Take into account a potential decrease in tolerance and isolation due to warm weather
- ✓ **Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses**
