CONTAINS:

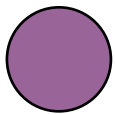
High levels of fentanyl and tested positive for benzodiazepines.

SUBSTANCE(S):

Purple pebbles, powder, dry.



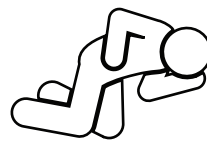

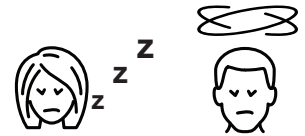

Sudden overdose.



Prolonged sedation and memory loss.

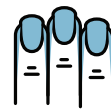
Overdose signs



Slow or NO breathing



Lips are blue



Nails are blue



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds



Person is not moving
Can't be woken up



Skin feels cold or clammy



Pupils are tiny
