Dear Parents, Guardians or Representatives,

RE: BC Government's COVID-19 immunization program for young people aged 12-17

The BC Government has announced youth aged 12-17 (born in 2009 or earlier) can now get a COVID-19 vaccine. The Pfizer vaccine is currently the only one licensed for use in people under the age of 18; all northern communities will have enough Pfizer vaccine for youth who want to be vaccinated.

Young people can go ahead and register and book a COVID-19 vaccination appointment (please refer to, [B.C. youth 12+ can register, get vaccinated against COVID-19](#)). In many communities, youth can book their appointment in a community clinic. In some communities, clinics will be organized with the schools. Find your community on the Northern Health COVID-19 Vaccine Plan webpage for more information.

Ways to register:

- Online (24 hours a day): getvaccinated.gov.bc.ca.

- In person at a [Service BC location](#) nearest you.

After you register you will be contacted to book your vaccine appointment.
