

3 STEPS TO GETTING THE COVID-19 VACCINE

1

Register online

Register online at getvaccinated.gov.bc.ca and get a confirmation number.

You need that number to later book your vaccination appointment.

Visit northernhealth.ca for more ways to register.



2

Book an appointment

You will be contacted to book a vaccine appointment when you are eligible based on your age and the immunization plan phases.

You will book your appointment online or by phone. You will select a location, date and time.



3

Get the vaccine

Visit the clinic to get your vaccine dose.

People who get their first vaccine dose will be notified by email, text, or phone when they are eligible to book an appointment for their second dose.
