COVID-19 vaccine clinics for Dease Lake Stikine and area



Beginning March 8, 2021, anybody over the age of 18+ can begin to call and book their first dose vaccine appointment through the Northern Health call centre, according to the staggered schedule below.

The Dease Lake (Stikine) clinics will run March 29, 2021 to April 1, 2021 at varying times at the Stikine Health Centre. You can expect your appointment duration to be approximately 10 minutes, with an additional 15 minute wait time before leaving the venue.

There may be variation in this info to the provincial schedule, as a result of Northern Health's small population sizes in some communities.

Your eligibility to call does not expire and you may call after the dates noted below. Depending on call volumes, there may be extended wait times to book an appointment. We appreciate your patience.

When you can call is based on your age

March 8, 2021

Seniors born in or before 1931 (90 years+)

May call starting on Monday March 8, 2021, to book their first dose vaccine appointment.

March 8, 2021

Indigenous peoples born in or before **1956** (**65** years+)

May call starting on Monday March 8, 2021, to book their first dose vaccine appointment.

March 10, 2021

Seniors born in or before 1941 (**80** years+)

May call starting on Wednesday March 10, 2021, to book their first dose vaccine appointment.

March 15, 2021

Community members born in or before 2003 (**18-79** years)

May call starting on Monday March 15, 2021, to book their first dose vaccine appointment.
