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Advance Care Planning Updates

Updated LearningHub Module, Facilitator Materials and Resource Binder

Advance Care Planning (ACP) is a process through which adults in BC share their wishes, beliefs, and values about their health care with loved ones or a substitute decision maker and their health care team. This process helps to inform and provide guidance to substitute decision makers if a person loses capacity make health care decisions. It also can inform and reduce the burden of health care decision making on loved ones and health care providers. It is important for health care providers to encourage patients and their loved ones to learn about and engage in this process to ensure they can successfully navigate health care decisions and receive health care that is in line with their wishes.
