DRUG CHARACTERISTICS

Substance(s)

A purple paste/sample sold as 'down' has tested positive for fentanyl, benzos and medetomidine.

Colour(s)



Purple

Response(s)

Overdoses leading to deep and prolonged sedation, and very low or no pulse. May result in death.

May require multiple doses of naloxone or may not respond to naloxone.

OVERDOSE SIGNS



Slow or NO breathing.



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds.



Person isn't moving.
Can't be woken up.






Lips & nails may look blue or grey



Skin feels cold or clammy.



Pupils are tiny.

Have a safety plan:

- On't use alone, use with someone you trust
- If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- Carry and know how to use naloxone
- Test a small amount and go slow
- Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses
