

## DRUG CHARACTERISTICS

### Substance(s)

A blue 'rock chunk' like substance being sold as 'heroin'.

## Colour(s)



Blue

### Response(s)

This substance is highly toxic, causing heavy and prolonged sedation, and requires more naloxone to reverse.

Overdoses occur when the substance is smoked and/or injected.

## **OVERDOSE SIGNS**



Slow or NO breathing.



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds.



Person isn't moving.
Can't be woken up.



Lips & nails may look blue or grey



Skin feels cold or clammy.



Pupils are tiny.

#### Have a safety plan:

- On't use alone, use with someone you trust
- If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- Carry and know how to use naloxone
- Test a small amount and go slow
- Take into account a potential decrease in tolerance and isolation due to cold weather
- Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses
