### **OVERDOSE SIGNS**



Slow or NO breathing.



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds.



Person isn't moving. Can't be woken up.



Lips & nails may look blue or grey



Skin feels cold or clammy.



**Pupils are** tiny.

#### **Drug checking (Terrace)**

Hours: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and

Friday, 8:30 am to 4 pm

#### Sample collection (Terrace)

Hours: 8:30 am to 8 pm, 7 days a week

#### Have a safety plan:

- On't use alone, use with someone you trust
- If alone, use the Lifeguard app
- When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- Carry and know how to use naloxone
- Test a small amount and go slow
- Take into account a potential decrease in tolerance and isolation due to cold weather
- Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses
