

DRUG CHARACTERISTICS

Substance

A green substance sold as "down".

Colour

Response

Linked to sudden overdoses with prolonged sedation requiring increased amount of Naloxone.

OVERDOSE SIGNS




Slow or NO breathing.



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds.




Person isn't moving. Can't be woken up.



Lips & nails may look blue or grey



Skin feels cold or clammy.



Pupils are tiny.

Drug checking: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, 8:30 am to 4 pm

Sample collection: 8:30 am to 8 pm, 7 days a week

Have a safety plan:

- ✓ Don't use alone, use with someone you trust
- ✓ If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- ✓ When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- ✓ Carry and know how to use naloxone
- ✓ Test a small amount and go slow
- ✓ Take into account a potential decrease in tolerance and isolation due to cold weather
- ✓ **Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses**
