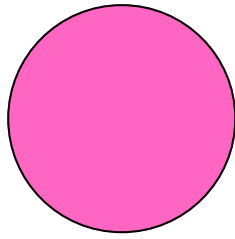

### DRUG CHARACTERISTICS

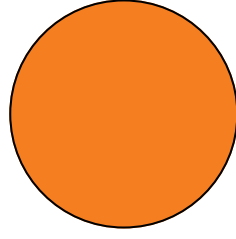
#### Substance

A pink substance with white flecks sold as “down”. Looks orange when crushed.

#### Colour



Pink

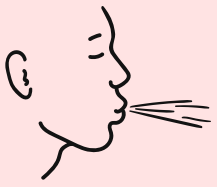


Orange

#### Response

Substance is highly toxic, causes heavy and prolonged sedation, and requires more naloxone to reverse.

### OVERDOSE SIGNS



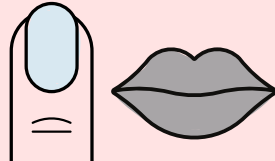
Slow or NO breathing.



Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds.



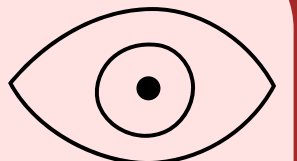
Person isn't moving. Can't be woken up.



Lips & nails may look blue or grey



Skin feels cold or clammy.



Pupils are tiny.

Sample drop off and drug checking available

#### Have a safety plan:

- ✓ Don't use alone, use with someone you trust
- ✓ If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- ✓ When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- ✓ Carry and know how to use naloxone
- ✓ Test a small amount and go slow
- ✓ Take into account a potential decrease in tolerance and isolation due to cold weather
- ✓ **Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses**
